

Amigurumi Shooting Star

Materials needed

Worsted weight yarn
Hook (any size, but I prefer to use 'H')
Stitch markers (5)
Scissors
Tapestry needle
Fiberfill stuffing
Stuffing tool
Colored yarn for accents

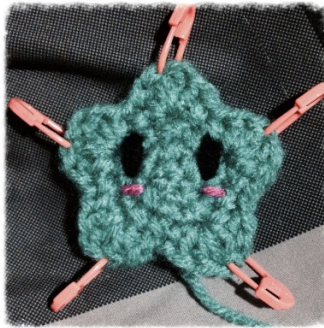
Abbreviations used

Magic ring = mr
Chain = ch
Single crochet = sc
Double crochet = dc
Slip stitch = sl st
Finish off = f/o



You will be making two sides to the star.

Note: you will need to leave a long tail on ONE of the star sides for sewing



1. Sc 5 into mr (5)
2. Sc 2 sc into each sc (10)
3. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc. Repeat four more times (15)
4. Sc in next 2 sc, 4 dc in next sc

Repeat four more times

F/o

Add eyes and blush marks to one of the star sides.

Match the sides of the star up, and use the stitch markers to hold the pieces together at each point.

Sew pieces together, careful to sew back loops ONLY.

Make sure to stuff the star before the hole is closed. The stuffing tool makes it easier to get the stuffing into each point.

Cut two short pieces of yarn, and use hook to loop each through on one side of bottom
